

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

March 25, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, March 25, 2014 at 8:30 A.M. All members were present and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on March 18, 2014, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Police Chief Keith England came forward to request that Officer Johnson from the Animal Shelter, be given authority to write ordinance violations. Officer Johnson was asked if this was something that he wanted or was interested in doing. He replied yes. There were no further questions. Mr. Williams moved to approve the request, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Next came, Dann Bird, Director of the Planning Commission, to request the placing of a sign at the northwest corner of State Road 9 & McKay Road. The sign is temporary for a period from April 6th thru April 20th. It is a joint effort for Crossroads Community Church and Hopes Point to announce an Easter service to be held at the High School. The sign is to be placed on the McKay Road right-of-way. Mr. Curtis Rhoadarmer appeared for questions. There will be other signs put at each individual church but no permits are required due to them being placed on their own private property. Mr. Finkel voiced his opinion that this is a great spot for a sign but he does not want this to become a common thing. Mr. Williams reminded Mr. Rhoadarmer to check with Holey Moley before digging and also the Police Dept. to make sure this will not obstruct anyone's view. There being no further discussion, Mr. Williams moved to approve the request for the sign, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
