

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

September 27, 2016

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, September 27, 2016, at 8:30 A.M. Mr. Williams was absent and on vacation, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on September 20, 2016, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, with the exception of APV #s 18003 through 18006 pending proper paperwork, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said once again the annual fall trash clean-up will be held for one week, from October 3 thru October 7, on their regular trash day.

Street Commissioner Jennifer Jones, on behalf of Livable Communities and Healthy Shelby County, requested a yard card be placed at Westar, from today until Saturday. Mr. Finkel moved to approve the request, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Alan Carbajal came forward to request permission to close the east half of the Circle for a Latino Festival on Saturday, October 22. It will be held from 10:00 A.M. until 3:00 P.M. Mr. Finkel moved to close the east half of the Circle at midnight Friday, and Mayor DeBaun seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mayor DeBaun announced that he and several representatives from the City and County went last Friday to Conner Prairie to accept an award. The award was from the Indiana Association of Landscape Architects, whereby the City received an excellence in design award for the City's Downtown Opportunities Plan. Mayor DeBaun wanted to thank everyone who participated in the process, and thanked Remenschneider and Associates for submitting it for approval.

There being no further business, Mr. Finkel moved to adjourn.
