

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

January 3, 2017

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, January 3, 2017, at 8:33 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on December 27, 2016, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Police Chief Mark Weidner said patrolman Matt Terkhorn has successfully completed one year of service with the City, and asked that he be permanently appointed as a police officer, effective today's date. Mr. Williams moved to approve the permanent appointment, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote. Mayor DeBaun asked the Chief to offer the Board's congratulations.

Under new business, Saretha Blake, a property management specialist with the Hendricks Pointe Apartments, asked permission to have a handicapped parking space and a loading/unloading zone be placed on Shelby Street. This is being requested to help a handicapped person, Duane Skinner, who lives at Hendricks Pointe, and he uses a walker to get around. The Shelby Street location would be much better for him to get to his apartment. The loading/unloading area would help people moving in or out of the Apartments during a two-hour period. There is no elevator in the building. The Board felt it was important that they visit the area before making a decision. Mr. Finkel moved to take the requests under advisement, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion to take it under advisement was approved on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
