Regular Meeting

January 24, 2017

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, January 24, 2017, at 8:30 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on January 17, 2017, and Mr. Finkel seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun said he had three requests for making temporary stop signs permanent. The first two are at Theobald and Swinford, and Premier and Swinford Streets. The third is at Intelliplex Drive by Makuta and Ivy Tech. Mr. Finkel moved to approve making the stop sign locations permanent, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote. Mayor DeBaun said City Attorney Trent Meltzer will now prepare an Ordinance to present to the City Council for their approval of making the stop sign locations permanent.
