

## BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

December 19, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, December 19, 2011, at 5:33 P.M. All Board members were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

Mr. Howard moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, December 13, 2011, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0-1 voice vote with Mayor Furgeson abstaining.

Mr. Howard moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, December 5, 2011, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0-1 voice vote with Mr. Barrick abstaining.

Mr. Barrick moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, November 29, 2011, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0-1 voice vote with Mr. Howard abstaining.

Mr. Howard moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

In new business, City Attorney Trent Meltzer presented trash violations for 329 West Mechanic Street, owned by Sandra Myers, 1800 South Meridian Street, owned by First Financial Bank, 112 North Walnut Street, owned by Trinidad Zamora, and 35 Walker Street owned by Deborah Johnson and Donna Nolley. There was no one in attendance to speak to the trash violations. Mr. Howard moved to fine the owners of 329 West Mechanic Street, 1800 South Meridian Street, 112 North Walnut Street, and 35 Walker Street, for their trash violations and have them added to the tax rolls of the properties, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mayor Furgeson, noting that this is his last Board of Works meeting, thanked Mr. Howard for his efforts on the Board and also thanked Mr. Barrick for his time and efforts over the past eight years on the Board. Mayor Furgeson also noted Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Carol Fowler is retiring after thirty years of service to the City. Mayor Furgeson also thanked Deputy Police Chief Dave Benefiel and Fire Chief Todd Anderson for their service. Mayor Furgeson recognized Plan Director Tom DeBaun for his eighteen years as Plan Commissioner and his efforts in working with the Board to make the City a better place to live. Mayor Furgeson finally recognized all of his department heads and thanked them for a job well done.

There being no further business, Mr. Howard moved to adjourn, and Mr. Barrick seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
