

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

April 18, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, April 18, 2011, at 5:31 P.M. Mr. Baumgartner was absent, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

Mr. Barrick moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, April 12, 2011, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Barrick moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

In new business, City Attorney Trent Meltzer reported that the City owns .89 acres of ground adjacent to Progress Parkway that is of no use to the City. Mr. Meltzer recommended that the City utilize the highest and best use to sell the land to adjacent landowners. Mr. Barrick moved that the .89 acres of ground adjacent to Progress Parkway be utilized to the highest and best use to sell the land to adjacent landowners, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Mayor Furgeson opened the meeting to the trash violations. Mr. Frankie Sundvall told the Board that he was in the process of removing the trash at his rental located at 126 East Locust Street, when the City removed all of it. Mr. Sundvall requested that the fine be waived because he was in the process of removing the trash. Mr. Barrick moved to waive the trash fine on the property located at 126 East Locust Street, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Continuing in new business, the resident of Lot 75 in Westar told the Board that he had just moved into the City from the county and didn't know the trash rules of the City. The resident requested that the fine be waived. Mr. Barrick moved to waive the trash fine on Lot 75 of Westar, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, the resident of Lot 82 in Westar told the Board that the boxes that were at her curbside were not trash but futon boxes with the futons in them. The resident requested that the fine be waived. Mr. Barrick moved to waive the trash fine on Lot 82 of Westar, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Barrick moved to adjourn, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mayor Furgeson reopened the Board meeting to ask if there were any other individuals present concerning trash fines. Mr. Barrick moved to fine the owners of the following properties for their trash violations and add those fines to the taxes of the property. The properties are as follows:

181-183 River Road
187-191 River Road
Lot 79 Westar

Mayor Furgeson seconded the motion. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

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Mr. Barrick moved to adjourn, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.
