

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

February 15, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, February 15, 2011, at 8:31 A.M. All Board members were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

Mr. Barrick moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, February 7, 2011, and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Baumgartner moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Mr. DeBaun requested an order to appear for HSBC Financial Services to address the property they own at 947 Morris Avenue in two weeks. Mr. DeBaun stated that HSBC received the certified mail sent to them by the City, but they have not responded. Mr. Barrick moved to order HSBC Financial Services to appear at the March 1st Board meeting, and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Baumgartner moved to adjourn, and Mr. Barrick seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
