

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

February 21, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, February 21, 2011, at 5:31 P.M. All Board members were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

Mr. Barrick moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, February 15, 2011, and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Baumgartner moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

In new business, Police Chief Bill Elliott presented a letter from Officer J. Michael McCracken announcing his retirement from the Police Department effective June 17, 2011. Mr. Baumgartner moved to accept the retirement of Office J. Michael McCracken effective June 17, 2011, and Mr. Barrick seconded. Mayor Furgeson thanked Officer McCracken for his fine service to the community over the past twenty years. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Chief Elliott presented a letter from Linda J. Amos, a dispatcher with the department, announcing her retirement effective June 6, 2011. Mr. Barrick moved to accept the retirement of Linda J. Amos effective June 6, 2011, and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. Mayor Furgeson thanked Ms. Amos for her service over the years. There was no public comment. The motion as carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Continuing in new business, Plan Commissioner Tom DeBaun presented a request from Candy Miller of the Grover Museum to allow a Schwann truck to be parked in front of the museum on April 2nd from 11:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. for a fundraiser for the Month of the Child project. Mr. Barrick moved to allow the parking of the truck in front of the Grover Museum, and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Mr. DeBaun reported that a tree on the property located at 1921 Shelby Street is split in the middle and is in danger of falling into the street. Mr. DeBaun added that Chase Bank is the owner of the property and all contact with them has been futile. Mr. DeBaun requested that the tree be removed and the cost of doing so be added to the tax rolls of the property. Mr. Baumgartner moved to remove the tree at 1921 Shelby Street and add the cost of doing so to the tax rolls of the property, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Continuing in new business, Mr. DeBaun requested an order to appear for Michael McDuffey, the owner of 421 ½ West Franklin Street, to address the condition of the property. Mr. Barrick moved to order Mr. Michael McDuffey to appear at the next Board meeting to address the condition of the property he owns at 421 ½ West Franklin Street, and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Finally in new business, City Attorney Trent Meltzer requested that the hearing date for Captain Doug Hasecuster be set for March 10, 2011 at 8:30 A.M. Mr. Barrick moved to accept the hearing date for Captain Doug Hasecuster for March 10, 2011, at 8:30 A.M., and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
