

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

January 11, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, January 11, 2011, at 8:31 A.M. All Board members were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

Mr. Baumgartner moved to approve the minutes of the regular meetings, December 20, 2010 and January 5, 2011, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Baumgartner moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

In old business, Police Chief Bill Elliott related to the Board that since Captain James Douglas Hasecuster has been convicted of a criminal offense, he is recommending that he continue to be suspended without pay until an internal investigation can be completed by the Shelbyville Police Department Disciplinary/Accident Review Board. Mr. Barrick moved to approve Chief Elliott's recommendation, and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

In new business, Chief Elliott requested approval of the Police Department's update of their rules and regulations. Mr. Barrick moved to approve the update in the Police Department's rules and regulations as set forth by Chief Elliott, and Mr. Baumgartner seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Chief Elliott requested to eliminate the hiring list that was presented to the Board on April 8, 2010. Chief Elliott added that the list was to be in effect for one year, but after careful consideration he feels it is in the best interest of the Department to start a new hiring process and list. Mr. Baumgartner moved to eliminate the Police Department's hiring list, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Baumgartner moved to adjourn, and Mr. Barrick seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
