

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

January 19, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, January 19, 2011, at 5:31 P.M. Mr. Barrick was absent, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

In new business, Police Chief Bill Elliott read a letter from Christopher Cecil stating that he was resigning as a reserve officer with the department effective January 18, 2011. Chief Elliott recommended that the Board accept this resignation. Mr. Baumgartner moved to accept the resignation of Christopher Cecil as a reserve officer with the department effective January 18, 2011, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Chief Elliott requested the appointment of Shawn Bennett to the rank of sergeant effective January 23, 2011. Chief Elliott added that Officer Bennett was chosen as the best candidate from a list of applicants interviewed separately by the Shelbyville Police Department Advisory Board and himself. Mr. Baumgartner moved to accept the appointment of Office Shawn Bennett to the rank of sergeant effective January 23, 2011, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Finally in new business, Chief Elliott requested the appointment of Deborah Haymond to the rank of detective effective January 23, 2011. Mr. Baumgartner moved to accept the appointment of Deborah Haymond to the rank of detective effective January 23, 2011, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Baumgartner moved to adjourn, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.
