

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

March 15, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, March 15, 2011, at 8:31 A.M. All Board members were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

Mr. Baumgartner moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, March 7, 2011, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

In old business, Plan Commissioner Tom DeBaun reported that the owners of 117 North Hamilton Street had thirty days to remove or remediate the property but have failed to do so. Mr. DeBaun requested an inspection warrant be issued to allow inspectors access to the property to assess the cost of demolition. In new business, Mayor Furgeson reported that representatives of Ryobi Die Casting were in the pre-meeting and requested that parallel parking be allowed on Mausoleum Road for a short period of time. Mr. Baumgartner moved to allow parallel parking on Mausoleum Road for a short period of time, and Mr. Barrick seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Baumgartner moved to adjourn, and Mr. Barrick seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
