

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

May 10, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, May 10, 2011, at 8:45 A.M. All Board members were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

Mr. Barrick moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, May 2, 2011, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Barrick moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

In old business, Plan Commissioner Tom DeBaun reported that Mr. Chad Morgan, the owner of 559 West Taylor Street, was ordered to appear at today's meeting to address concerns about his property. Mr. DeBaun added that Mr. Morgan is not in attendance and asked that the Board order the property to be remediated or removed within the next thirty days. Mr. Barrick moved to remediate or remove the property within the next thirty days, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

In new business, Mr. DeBaun presented a list of properties that are in violation of the grass ordinance of the City. Mr. DeBaun recommended that the properties be mowed and maintained throughout the mowing season and assess the cost of doing so to the taxes of the properties. The properties are as follows:

Mr. Barrick moved to close the east half of the Circle on May 14th from 6:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Finally in new business, Ms. Amy Haacker of Mainstreet Shelbyville requested that the east side of the Circle be closed from midnight to noon on each Saturday starting on May 21st and running through October 15th for the Farmer's Market. Mr. Barrick moved to close the east side of the Circle from midnight to noon on each Saturday starting May 21st and running through October 15th, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.
