

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

January 17, 2012

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, January 17, 2012 at 8:31 A.M. All board members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting January 10, 2012, and Mr. Williams seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Mr. Finkel moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under old business, Mayor DeBaun asked City Engineer Rodger Keller to update the Board on the bids that were opened on November 21, 2011, for the Sanitary Sewer Extension along the Fairland Road Extension West Connector Corridor. Of the eight bids that were received, the prices ranged from \$987,508.00 to \$1,473,589.00. Mr. Keller said the engineer's estimate was around \$2,000,000.00. The lowest bid came from King's Trucking and Excavation, Inc., out of Seymour, Indiana. Out of all the checks with other communities and INDOT that had been done on King's Trucking, Mr. Keller said there were no complaints on any of their work. Mr. Keller recommended the Board's approval of King's Trucking. Mayor DeBaun asked if their bonds had been posted? Mr. Keller said they had posted a bid bond, and once this is approved, they will post a performance and payment bond. Mr. Finkel moved to approve King's Trucking and Excavation for the Sanitary Sewer project, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun commended Street Commissioner Jennifer Jones and her crew for removing the tree in such a quick manner that was talked about at last week's Board meeting.

There being no further business, Mr. Finkel moved to adjourn, and Mr. Williams seconded. Motion carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
