

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

October 11, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on October 11, 2011, at 8:31 A.M. Mr. Barrick was absent, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

Mr. Howard moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting, October 3, 2011, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Mr. Howard moved to approve the claims as presented, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

In old business, Mayor Furgeson asked Plan Commissioner Tom DeBaun if the work on the roof of the Cavalier's Club ceases to continue, will the City's order to vacate still be in effect. Mr. DeBaun recommended that a week by week extension be granted depending on the work on the roof. Mayor Furgeson stated that he is inclined to grant the Cavalier's Club an extension to October 31st. Mr. Howard moved to grant an extension to the Cavalier's Club until October 31st to complete their roof repairs, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

In new business, Mr. DeBaun reported that the Police Department had notified his department about people stripping wire from the basement of an abandoned house located at 122 East Mechanic Street. Mr. DeBaun added that the Police Department requested that the property be secured and it was. Mr. Howard moved to formally secure the property located at 122 East Mechanic Street and assess the cost of doing so to the taxes of the property, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Mr. DeBaun reported that Mr. Jeff Williams of Major Hospital has requested that the City formally accept and dedicate Intelliplex Drive for the purpose of maintenance issues. Mr. Howard moved to accept and dedicate Intelliplex Drive, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

Finally in new business, Mr. DeBaun presented the street mileage update calculation for INDOT for Berwick Drive, Lee Boulevard, Pebble Point Drive, Progress Parkway Phase 3A, Progress Parkway Phase 3B and Stonehedge Way totaling 3.098 miles for acceptance and dedication. Mr. Howard moved to accept and dedicate the streets as stated, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Howard moved to adjourn, and Mayor Furgeson seconded. The motion was carried on a 2-0 voice vote.
