

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

Regular Meeting

October 25, 2011

The regular meeting of the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on October 25, 2011, at 8:33 A.M. All Board members were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided.

In old business, Mayor Furgeson reported that there is an unnamed street that runs from Mausoleum Road to Industrial Drive that needs to be dedicated to the City. Plan Commissioner Tom DeBaun related to the Board that he will supply a list of names at the next Board meeting for the Board to choose from to name the street. Mr. Barrick moved to dedicate the unnamed street from Mausoleum Road to Industrial Drive to the City, and Mr. Howard seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

In new business, City Engineer Rodger Keller requested permission to bid for sewer work for the Fairland Road project. Mr. Keller noted that the construction of the sewers should commence in January or February of next year. Mr. Barrick moved to grant permission to bid for sewer work for the Fairland Road project, and Mr. Howard seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Barrick moved to adjourn, and Mr. Howard seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.
