

SHELBYVILLE PUBLIC UTILITY BOARD

Regular Meeting

March 19, 2013

The regular meeting of the Public Utility Board of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, March 19, 2013, at 8:29 A.M. All members were present and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting February 26, 2013, and Mr. Finkel seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said there was a request by the Popplewell family, on their home at 1916 S. Riley Hwy., to waive the tap fee for connection to the sanitary sewer system. Mrs. Popplewell inherited the home from her father, and she didn't realize he was on a septic system, which is causing problems, and the septic system can no longer be used. The reason they asked to waive the tap fee was because they've paid sewer bills for several years, but they've not been connected to the sewer system. Charles Popplewell was present, saying he's currently unemployed, and his wife was the only one working right now. Mayor DeBaun said he visited the site last Friday, and he said he personally thinks the problems they have is with their contractor and INDOT. Mr. Finkel moved to waive the connection fee, but charge for the \$25.00 inspection fee, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
