

SHELBYVILLE PUBLIC UTILITY BOARD

Regular Meeting

May 20, 2014

The regular meeting of the Public Utility Board of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, May 20, 2014, at 8:29 A.M. All members were present, and Mayor DeBaun presided.

Mr. Williams moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting May 13, 2014, and Mr. Finkel seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Mayor DeBaun said Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent Brad Fix had a recommendation regarding a Vactor 2100 truck. Brad requested permission to purchase a combination sewer cleaning truck from Jack Doheny Companies. Their current Vactor 2100 truck is eleven years old, and it's going to the Stormwater Utility. On the new truck, it will be paid by both the Treatment Plant and the Stormwater Utility. Brad said the truck was bid in Michigan through advertising bids, and then other government communities can purchase the Vactor trucks through them. Brad said the cost of the Vactor 2100 was \$364,882.65, and they're trading in an old motor for \$5,000.00, so the total cost will be under \$360,000.00. Under discussion, Brad said the new truck is expected to last over a decade. Mr. Finkel asked Brad what the cost is to install a sewer line. Brad said it would probably be over \$50.00 per foot, and the City has over eight miles of sewer lines. Mr. Finkel moved to approve Brad's request, and Mr. Williams seconded. The motion was carried on a 3-0 voice vote.

There being no further business, Mr. Williams moved to adjourn.
