

COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

January 5, 2011

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, January 5, 2011, at 7:00 P.M. All Councilmen were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilman Val Phares and Councilman Sponsel followed that with prayer.

Councilman Fero moved to accept the minutes of the regular meeting, December 20, 2010, and Councilman Nolley seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 6-0-1 voice vote with Councilman Asher abstaining.

In other business, Mayor Furgeson stated that on the first meeting in January, an organizational meeting of the Council is to be held to elect its President and Reader. Councilman Fero nominated Councilman Rob Nolley for Council President, and Councilman David Phares seconded. Councilman Sponsel moved to close nominations, and Councilwoman Owens seconded. The motion to close nominations was carried on a 7-0 voice vote. The motion to elect Councilman Nolley as Council President was carried on a 7-0 voice vote. Councilman David Phares moved to nominate Councilman Fero as Reader and Councilman Asher seconded. Councilman Nolley moved to close nominations, and Councilwoman Owens seconded. The motion to close nominations was carried on a 7-0 voice vote. The motion to elect Councilman Fero as Reader was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.

In old business, Ordinance No. 10-2667, amending salary ordinance No. 10-2653, was considered on second and final reading. Councilman Fero moved to adopt this ordinance on second and final reading, and Councilman David Phares seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.

In new business, the naming of Council Committees and Chairmen of such committees for 2011 was considered. Councilman Nolley moved to approve the Council Committees and Chairman of such committees the same as 2010, and Councilman Sponsel seconded. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, the naming of Council Liaison appointments for 2011 was considered. Councilman Nolley moved to keep the liaison appointments the same for 2011 as they were for 2010, and Councilman Fero seconded. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.

There was no miscellaneous business, reports from committees, boards and commissions.

Mayor Furgeson related that the Christmas decorations in the downtown area will be removed this week.

There being no further business, Councilman Asher moved to adjourn, and Councilman David Phares seconded. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.
