

COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

May 2, 2011

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on May 2, 2011, at 7:00 P.M. All Council members were present, and Mayor Furgeson presided. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilman Val Phares and he followed that with prayer.

Councilman Fero moved to accept the minutes of the regular meeting, April 18, 2011, and Councilman Nolley seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 6-0-1 voice vote with Councilman Val Phares abstaining.

In old business, Mr. Steve Schrumpf, attorney for KN Platech America Corporation, was present to answer any questions on their compliance with statement of benefits forms. Mr. Schrumpf reported that KN Platech started operations in September, 2010 and productions started with two machines and twenty employees in March of this year. Mr. Schrumpf added that by the end of the year there should be thirty employees, and nine machines and forty employees by the end of 2013. Councilman Fero inquired as to the number of parts that KN Platech will manufacture. Mr. Randie Danhauer replied that they are making one part at this time but will be transferring other parts from Japan in the near future. Councilman Fero moved to approve the compliance with statement of benefit forms for KN Platech America Corporation, and Councilman Nolley seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.

Also in old business, Ordinance No. 11-2670, to amend the sign code of the City of Shelbyville, was considered on second and final reading. Councilman Fero moved to adopt this ordinance on second and final reading with amending Section 1 of 98.16, 98.11 and clarification of items F, G and adding H, and Councilman Sponsel seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote. Councilwoman Owens asked if there is a plan to notify the public about this ordinance. Plan Commissioner Tom DeBaun replied that he plans to utilize the local newspaper and radio station for notification purposes.

There was no new business.

There was no miscellaneous business, reports from committees, boards and commissions or comments or requests from citizens.

There being no further business, Councilman Asher moved to adjourn, and Councilman David Phares seconded. The motion was carried on a 7-0 voice vote.
