

COMMON COUNCIL

Regular Meeting

October 17, 2011

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Shelbyville, Indiana, was held in the Common Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, October 17, 2011, at 7:00 P.M. Councilman Val Phares was absent, and Mayor Furgeson presided. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilman Asher, and Councilman Fero followed that with prayer.

Councilman Fero moved to accept the minutes of the regular meeting, October 3, 2011, and Councilwoman Owens seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

In old business, Ordinance No. 11-2676, the 2012 budget, was considered on second and final reading. Councilman Fero moved to adopt this ordinance on second and final reading, and Councilman Nolley seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

In new business, Ordinance No. 11-2679, enacting and adopting a supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Shelbyville, was considered on first reading. Councilman Fero moved to adopt this on first reading, and Councilman Sponsel seconded. There was no public comment. The motion was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

Also in new business, Resolution No. 2011-26, adoption of Strategic Community Investment Plan, was considered. Councilman Fero moved to adopt this resolution, and Councilwoman Owens seconded. Mayor Furgeson noted that this resolution will aid Real America in their application for tax credits for the rehabilitation of the old Hendricks School. There was no public comment. The motion as carried on a 6-0 voice vote.

There was no miscellaneous business, reports form committees, boards and commissions, or comments or requests from citizens.

Mayor Furgeson asked the students in attendance to stand and introduce themselves.

There being no further business, Councilman Asher moved to adjourn, and Councilman Nolley seconded. The motion was carried on a 6-0 voice vote.
