SHELBYVILLE BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS MEETING MINUTES August 9, 2022

to that. It seems as though that the variance will still allow to you know the both structures to fit within the same density model of the surrounding area. So I like that, I like that. The other thing that I will note is that so the last component for us with this type of variance is the practical difficulty. But after hearing a little bit more about the timeline of the project, I'm convinced that we arrived to this place in good faith.
